

ACCESS TO GROUNDS

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| \$25.00 | Pg 6 - Each member is entitled to one (1) gate card. Replacement for lost cards will be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each card. Anytime a membership is sold, the selling member must turn in to the office, each of the cards, or purchase to replace lost cards. Cards damaged through normal wear and tear, must be presented to the Board for inspection, and can be replaced at no cost to the member. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 6 - Using a members card to enter PFCC by a non-member is not allowed and the member will be fined. |
| \$15.00 | Pg 6 - Tailgating is not allowed and the member who allows this will be fined. |

CODE OF CONDUCT

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| \$100.00 | Pg 7 - Mistreatment of employees and volunteers is prohibited |
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ILLEGAL, PROHIBITED, CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

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| \$50.00 | Pg 8 - The use of firearms including but not limited to, sling shots, archery equipment, BB guns/pellet guns on Club grounds is STRICTLY prohibited. |
| \$500.00 | Pg 8 - The use of fireworks on PFCC property is strictly prohibited. |
| Termination | Pg 8 - No illegal activities are allowed on PFCC property. Illegal drugs will not be brought in, manufactured, grown, sold or used at PFCC. |
| \$250 or termination | Pg 8 - Vandalism, littering, graffiti. |
| \$250 or termination | Pg 8 - Repeated public intoxication whether of alcohol or drugs. |
| Termination | Pg 8 - Larceny |
| \$50.00 | Pg 8 - Disturbance of the peace by member(s) or their pets/guests uninvited intrusions onto another's campsite |
| \$50.00 | Pg 8 - Trespassing on other member's campsites, cutting across for shortcuts, parking without permission, occupation of without permission, uninvited intrusion. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 8 - Exceeding the speed limits, reckless driving and underage unsupervised driving. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 8 - Filthy or extreme language. |
| \$100.00 | Pg 8 - Being a nuisance is especially prohibited by actions and or by word, beligerence, obnoxiousness, slurs or comments of a biased or prejudiced nature that insult another member and or their guest's race, creed, color, ethnic background, religious virtues etc. Creating or spreading rumors of a false nature for the sole purpose of being unpleasant. |
| \$250.00 or termination | Pg 8 - Fighting or intimidating another member or their guest(s) to attempt confrontation, unwanted or unwarranted physical contact. |

MINORS

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| \$25.00 | Pg 9 - Minors will not be allowed in the Clubhouse after 10:00pm |
| \$250.00 | Pg 9 - No member guest shall furnish alcohol for consumption by persons less than 21 years of age on PFCC property. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 19 - All riders on bikes, motorized and non-motorized scooters are required to wear a helmet and appropriate safety gear at all times on PFCC property. |

CAMPSITES

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| \$50.00 | Pg 11- Any member that leaves their campsite with an unattended fire and/or coal burning/smoldering will be guilty of a violation of these rules. When no campfires or buring is allowed on Club property, a RED FLAG will be flown at the main gate, and "No Camp Fires" signs will be posted at all bathrooms. The RED FLAG will be taken down and all signs removed from the bathrooms by the Club Ranger, when the fire danger is past. |
| \$50.00 | Pg 7 - Memberships are for the use of members and their guests and will not be rented or otherwise commercialized. |
| \$250.00 | Pg 15 - All trees on the Club grounds belong to the Club. No live trees over 4" in diameter will be cut down without permission, granted by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors has the authority to remove any tree or trees that are now or may become a safety hazard. Requests are made to the PFCC Ranger. |

CAMPSITES CONTINUED

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| \$50.00 | Pg 14 - Quiet hours are in effect from 10:00pm to 8:00pm |
| \$50.00 | Pg 14 - Members are responsible for their individual waste containers on their sites, and for burning of flammable materials such as limbs, brush and stumps on the member's sites. Large quantities of acceptable flammable materials should be taken to a designated site as directed by the Club Ranger. The Club Ranger will supervise all burning on Club property. Flammable materials will not be brought to the Club trash for disposal. |
| \$250.00 | Pg 15 - Poisoning and/or abuse of animals and birds on campsites or Club property are prohibited, with the exception of poisoning of Rats and Mice in a controlled area. |
| Termination | Pg 23 - No more than 10 total propane tanks per campsite. |
| \$100.00 | Pg 10 - A limit of 20 days maximum per guest per year. |

COMFORT STATIONS - LAUNDRY FACILITIES

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| \$500.00 | Pg 21 - No powdered soap or any other powder will be put into the washing machines or dryers. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 21 - Clean lint traps after each use. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 21 - Do not overload machine. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 20-21 - Clean up after using the facilities (Comfort stations and laundry areas) |
| \$25.00 | Pg 20 - No dishes or clothing will be washed in the bathrooms. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 20 - No items of any type, from campsites, will be placed in the trash containers in the bathrooms. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 20 - The Ranger shall maintain utilities in the comfort stations. No one will adjust the utilities that have been shut off for the season. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 21 - No pet bedding in PFCC washers or dryers. |

PETS

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| \$25.00 | Pg 13 - Dogs, cats and other approved pets will be on leashes or under control when not on their owner's site. There will be not more than two pets allowed per campsite. No pet will be allowed to run free on the Club grounds. Any pet caught roaming the Club Grounds, unattended, will be caught and tied up. If the pet owner cannot be found, the Club Ranger or a Board member will be authorized to call the local Animal Control. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 13 - No pets will be allowed in the comfort stations, the clubhouse, or the bar except for registered service animals. |
| remove from club | Pg 13 - No more than 3 domestic pets per household. |

VEHICLES (INCLUDING GOLF CARTS)

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| \$250.00 | Pg 18 - PFCC has no provision or areas acceptable for off road motorcycle riding. ATV's or any other form of off road vehicle, except golf-carts that were manufactured as such, modified golf carts (customized) are acceptable as long as they are used solely for the purpose of transport only (from point a to b) and abide by the speed limits. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 19 - Speed limit on the main road (from the gate to the end of the road) is 10 mph. The speed limit at the clubhouse and on all side roads and lanes is 5 mph. Use of a vehicle on the Club grounds is a priviledge, not a right. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 19 - Vehicles entering the main road from side roads must stop and yield right of way. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 18 - The driver of any street vehicle at PFCC must possess a valid driver's license or a learner's permit and have an adult with a valid license riding with him/her. |
| \$50.00 | Pg 19 - Parking will be only in designated areas or within campsites. All authorized vehicles may be parked on a member's campsite as long as they are completely on the member's campsite and do not cause a hazard to passing vehicles. |
| remove from club | Pg 18 - All members and guests must have proof of liability insurance for any/all motorized vehicles driven on Club grounds |
| \$75 or remove | Pg 18 - Inoperable vehicles of any kind are prohibited on member's campsites. Any/all types of vehicles must be maintained and movable. Any/all vehicles must be removed from PFCC. |
| \$75 or remove | Pg 18 - Members are required to register the make, model, color, and tag number of all vehicles with the front office. |

VEHICLES (INCLUDING GOLF CARTS) CONTINUED

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| \$75 or remove | Pg 17 - A second RV may remain on the member's campsite for a period not to exceed six (6) months. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 19 - Golf carts must maintain same speed limits as automobiles and yield right of way when entering main road |
| \$25.00 | Pg 19 - Drivers under the age of 14 years must be accompanied by a driver 14 years or older, sitting in the passenger seat adjacent to the driver and capable of taking control in an emergency situation. All persons driving a cart must be physically large enough to sit on the driver's seat and reach all controls without moving. |
| COMMUNITY - SHARED SPACES (Bar, Clubhouse, etc) | |
| \$50.00 | Pg 19 - No member or guest(s) may bring their own beer or any alcoholic drink into the clubhouse/bar/fence area (adjacent to the bar), while the bar is open for business. |
| Varies | Pg 20 - Cost of any damage caused to the clubhouse or equipment by misconduct of a member or by a member's guest(s) will be paid by the member |
| \$25.00 | Pg 22 - If any adult member (or member's guest) is caught fishing in the pond, without a fishing license there will be a fine. |
| \$25.00 | Pg 22 - No swimming or boats in the pond (unless directed by the Board of Directors. |
| \$50.00 | Pg 15 - Due to limited capacity of the Club well, and to conserve water, no Club roads will be watered. There shall be limited use of watering lawns, washing vehicles and or RV's. All hose bibs shall have backflow preventers as installed by the Club. |
| \$50.00 | Pg 14 - Trash and/or garbage, outside PFCC grounds will not be brought to the Club for disposal. Trash and/or garbage generated within PFCC grounds will be placed in the approved containers provided by the Club. Items other than household garbage (i.e. furniture, mattresses, appliances, auto parts, paint, etc.) will be removed from the Club grounds by the member. Litter will not be transplanted to or left at the designated burning site. Littering of Club property is prohibited. |
